

Guided Pathway 1: English Baccalaureate (Ebacc)

Guided Pathway 2: Broad and Balanced Curriculum

At least one of the following: Geography, History, French or Spanish

Any THREE further subject choices

Pathway 1: The EBacc is made up of the subjects which are considered essential to access a wide variety of A Level courses and to study degree level.

Pathway 2: Broad and Balanced ensures a good range of subjects in order to prepare you for multiple Post-16 and Post-18 pathways.

Initial Interest Form




Thursday 16th and Friday 17th January 2025.
